- 3. <u>Fire Department</u> 10 calls for the month of December; Participated in Toys for Joy and Light Parade in Santa Rosa; Participated in the Christmas Festivities in Vaughn; Upcoming trainings CPR & AED, Structure Fires, and Patient Care.
- 4. <u>Project Manager</u> Progress Report Updates; Power Dam Update; Blue Hole Restrooms awaiting fixtures and panels; Had to adjust schedule and had change orders; Street Lighting is in the design phase; El Rito/Park Lake Pedestrian Bridges are set to start in March; 5th Street Project upcoming construction; Emergency Repair to Sewer Line should be finalized this week; Barela Road is in the design phase; Design should be completed by March.
- 5. <u>Steve Farmer (Grants Consultant)</u> Blue Hole Parking Lot Solar Project Update (gave packet to Council); 2 funding options available for this project; Wetlands Restoration planned for Power Dam; Dog Valley Funding \$1.1 million; EPA Grant being pursued currently for this project; Dog Park Spoke with engineer and plans are done; Money for Golf Course Seeking Private Initiatives (PGA); Route 66 Commission Golf Course Spotlight on four throughout New Mexico; Clean up efforts on Route 66 are ongoing.
- 6. <u>Rebecca Stair (EMNRD Director)</u> Electricity is an economic driver; Federal funding is available for Solar Project; Tax credits are available for municipalities; Size of the project would depend on billing; Councilman Bravo asked if she thought about the job impact in this community; She stated that is something to look into as far as what type of project to consider; Do not want to have anyone lose their job.
